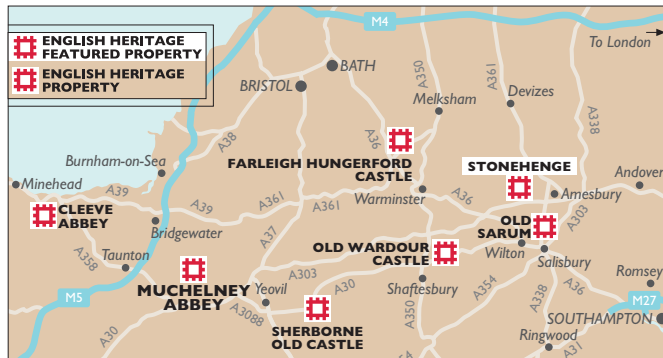

Stonehenge

The great and ancient stone circle of Stonehenge is unique; an exceptional survival from a prehistoric culture now lost to us. The monument evolved between 3,000 BC and 1,600 BC and is aligned with the rising and setting of the sun at the solstices, but its exact purpose remains a mystery. To this day the World Heritage Site of Stonehenge endures as a source of inspiration and fascination and, for many, a place of worship and celebration.

- An awe-inspiring place to visit, visitors to Stonehenge can discover the history and legends which surround this unique stone circle with a complimentary audio tour available in 10 languages (subject to availability)
